



Childrens Hygiene Kit – Value \$13

Purpose

Kids Hygiene kits provide comfort for children who have been affected by disaster. It is similar to an adult hygiene kit with a few modifications. Do not remove items from original packaging

Contents

- 1 hand towel approximately 15" x 17". Consider bright colors or child themes (cartoons, etc.)
- 1 washcloth Also in bright colors or child themes
- 1 comb child-themed combs are perfect
- 1 bath size soap kid-themed bar soap is ideal. No strong fragrances. If you get adult soap use something mild.
- 1 toothbrush child-sized
- 1 toothpaste tube child themed
- 6 adhesive bandages (Band-aids) with child themes (Paw Patrol, PJ Masks, Spidey, other cartoons)
- 1 one-gallon ZipLoc bag

Important to Know:

- All items must be new.
- Do not wash any of the items or they will be considered used and not allowed
- Please remove all packaging except bar of soap wrapping
- Do not include any money or additional material in the kits

Assembly Directions

- 1. Place the hand towel flat on a work surface.
- 2. Place the washcloth flat and centered on top of the hand towel.
- 3. Place all remaining items on top of the washcloth as neatly as possible, oriented in the same direction.
- 4. Fold over the short sides of the hand towel to cover all of the items.
- 5. Fold over one long side of the hand towel so that it covers all of the items. Grasp the bundle of items tightly and roll over the remainder of the hand towel tightly.
- 6. Place the tightly rolled bundle in the plastic bag.
- 7. Remove as much air as possible and seal the bag.

For In-Person Delivery

- Notify us in advance of your collection campaign as needs change daily.

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- Once your collection efforts are complete and before departure for the Rome
 Warehouse or Dallas Depot, please prepare a summary list of your collection and
 send to the respective manager Mike Kennamer @ mkennamer@pcanet.org for kits
 going to the Rome GA Warehouse, or to Rick Lenz @ rlenz@pcanet.org for kits going
 to the Dallas Depot. We must know what you will be bringing so that we can
 coordinate your arrival, be prepared to let us know the exact day and time of arrival
 so that we can have staff available.
- We can accommodate mid-size U-Haul or Ryder type box trucks, pickup trucks, flat bed and enclosed trailers, or cars for deliveries. Tractor-trailers are also okay; a loading dock, fork truck and pallet jacks are on site. Volunteers should accompany the delivery of the relief kits and be prepared to help unload once arriving at the MNA Warehouse.
- Volunteer wavers are needed for each individual visiting the warehouse or depot.

- If you anticipate the need for overnight accommodations while you are making a
 delivery at the Rome Warehouse please notify us in advance; we may be able to
 arrange lodging. Please know that housing may be limited and a morning delivery
 will work best so you can get back out the same day if at all possible, especially in
 times of new disaster responses and there is elevated activity at the warehouse or
 depot.
